WHAT THE CHOSEN RECIPIENT WILL RECEIVE

A \$10,000 cash contribution

To be paid in two parts:

- \$3,000 on successfully gaining entrance to a New Zealand university with the intention to study law; and
- \$7,000 to be paid on successfully being accepted into Law Part II.

Work experience Upon completion of your second year of study, you'll be invited to join Sharp Tudhope during the summer break to undertake paid work experience.

Mentorship You'll be matched with a mentor from Sharp Tudhope who will be available to support you during your studies.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Sharp Tudhope Law Scholarship you must:

1. Be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
2. Be in Year 13 at an eligible school (see list opp)
3. Have achieved at least NCEA Level 2 endorsed with merit, or equivalent
4. Enrol for full-time study in the year following application with the intention to pursue a law degree at a New Zealand University.

Sharp Tudhope will also assess eligibility by considering leadership potential and community involvement.
